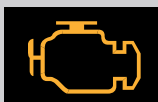

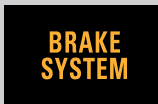

Release



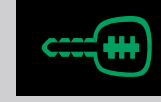
Low fuel:

Use other vehicle key and see your dealer



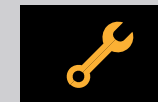
Low tire pressure:
