Briefly appear with each engine start. Red and amber indicators are most critical. Blue and green indicators are used for general information. See your Owner's Manual for more information.

If an indicator remains on, there may be a problem; see your dealer

 Charging system	 EPS (electric power steering)
 Low brake fluid, Brake system	 Malfunction indicator lamp (check engine light)
 Low oil pressure	 VSA [®] (vehicle stability assist)
 SRS (supplemental restraint system)	 TPMS (tire pressure monitoring system)
 Transmission (blinking)	 E-DPS* (all-wheel drive)
 ABS (anti-lock brake system)	 DRL (daytime running lights)
