

Connecting Devices and Playing Audio

1. Open the glove box, and pull out the USB adapter cable.





Connect the USB connector to your iPod dock connector or flash drive.

2. Press USB/AUX until iPod or USB appears.






3. **Press** (⋈) (⋈) or (+) (-) to change tracks.


Play audio files from your compatible phone through your vehicle's audio system. Visit handsfreelink.honda.com to check if this feature is available on your phone.

Playing Bluetooth Audio

- 1. Make sure your phone is on and paired to HandsFreeLink (see page II).
- 2. Press USB/AUX until "Bluetooth Audio" appears on the screen.




3. From your phone, **open** the desired audio player or app and begin playing. Sound is redirected to the audio system. Make sure the volume on your phone is properly adjusted.



4. **Press** (⋈) (⋈) or (+) (-) to change tracks.









Notes:

- You may need to enable additional Bluetooth settings on your phone for playback.
- The play/pause function and remote audio controls may not be supported on all
- phones. Operate your phone only when your vehicle is stopped.
