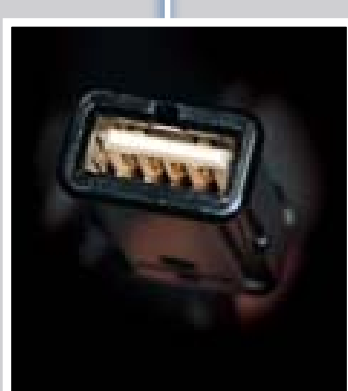


## iPod® OR USB FLASH DRIVE

Play audio files from your compatible iPod or USB flash drive through your vehicle's audio system.

### Connecting Devices and Playing Audio

1. **Open** the glove box, and **pull out** the USB adapter cable.

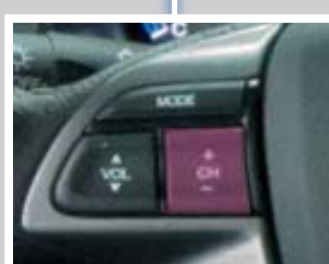
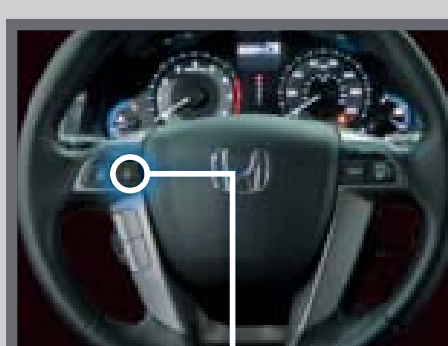
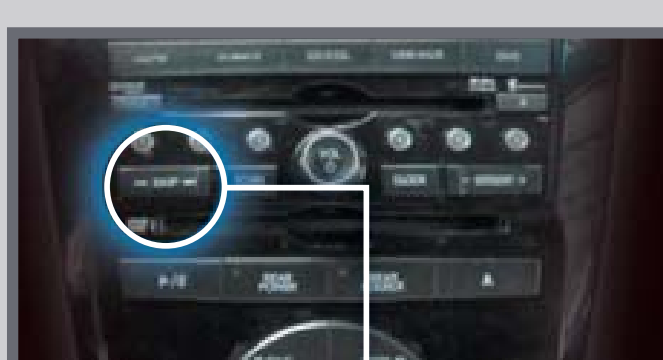


**Connect** the USB connector to your iPod dock connector or flash drive.

2. **Press** USB/AUX until iPod or USB appears.



3. **Press** (⏮) (⏭) or (+) (-) to change tracks.



**Note:** Connect your device only when your vehicle is stopped.

## BLUETOOTH® AUDIO

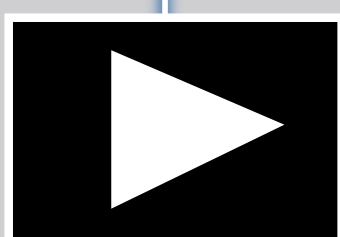
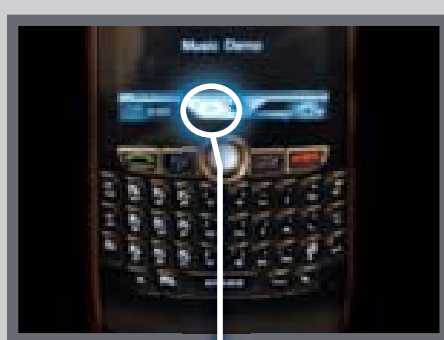

### Playing Bluetooth Audio

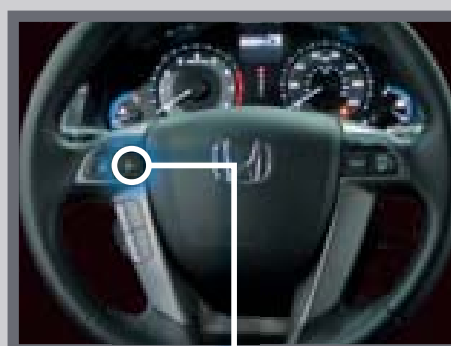
1. Make sure your phone is on and paired to HandsFreeLink (see **page 11**).
2. **Press** USB/AUX until "Bluetooth Audio" appears on the screen.



3. From your phone, **open** the desired audio player or app and begin playing. Sound is redirected to the audio system. Make sure the volume on your phone is properly adjusted.



4. **Press** (⏮) (⏭) or (+) (-) to change tracks.



#### Notes:

- You may need to enable additional Bluetooth settings on your phone for playback.
- The play/pause function and remote audio controls may not be supported on all phones.
- Operate your phone only when your vehicle is stopped.
