FORWARD COLLISION WARNING (FCW)

Alerts you to the possibility of a front-end collision.

How It Works

If the camera mounted between the windshield and the rearview mirror detects a vehicle in front of you when your vehicle speed is 10 mph or higher—and it determines there is a likelihood of a frontal collision—the system provides you with visual and audible warnings.



FCW may not activate under certain conditions. See your Owner's Manual for more information.

Customizing FCW

Use the interface dial to make and enter selections.


I. Press SETTINGS.



2. **Select** Vehicle Settings.



3. **Move** the interface dial to the right to Driver Assist Style.



4. **Select** Forward Collision Warning Distance.



5. **Select** one of the options.

Long: early warning timing

Normal: standard warning timing

Short: late warning timing
Off: turn the system off



6. **Press** BACK to exit the menu.
