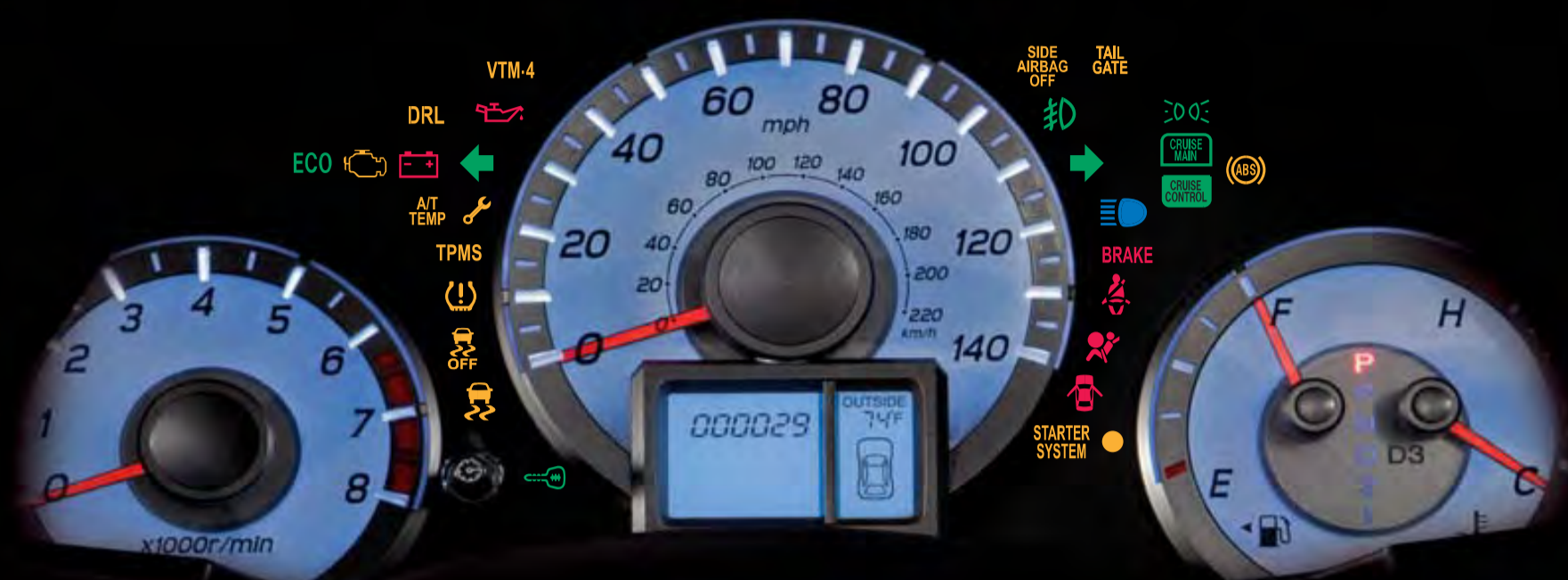













INSTRUMENT PANEL INDICATORS

Malfunction Indicators





If an indicator remains on, there may be a problem; see your dealer

 Charging system	 Anti-Lock Brake System (ABS)
 Low brake fluid, Brake system	 Variable Torque Management (VTM-4) (4WD only)
 Low oil pressure	 Malfunction lamp (check engine light)
 Supplemental Restraint System (SRS)	 Vehicle Stability Assist® (VSA)
 Daytime Running Lights (DRL)	 Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS)
 Power tailgate	











Condition Indicators

Action is needed by driver

 Parking brake on: Release	 Low fuel: Refill
 Door/Tailgate open: Close door(s) / tailgate	 Low tire pressure: Add air
 Seat belt reminder: Fasten seat belt(s)	 Maintenance Minder™: Make dealer appointment

 Starter system: Hold ignition switch in START (III) for up to 15 seconds	 Immobilizer (<i>blinks</i>): Use other vehicle key and see dealer
 A/T temperature (4WD only): Pull over and let engine idle	 VTM-4 (<i>blinks</i>): Pull over and let engine idle

On/Off Indicators

 PASSENGER AIRBAG OFF (located on center panel)	 Fog lights on
 SIDE AIRBAG OFF	 Exterior lights on
 VSA OFF	 Turn signals/hazards on
 CRUISE MAIN on	 High beams on
 CRUISE CONTROL on	 Fuel economy on
