# AUDIO AND CONNECTIVITY

Learn how to operate the vehicle's audio system.

# **Basic Audio Operation**

Connect audio devices and operate buttons and displays for the audio system.

### USB Port

Install the iPod® USB connector or the USB flash drive to the USB port.

**Tip:** To prevent any potential issues, be sure to use an Apple MFi Certified Lightning Connector for Apple CarPlay<sup>TM</sup> or a USB cable certified by USB-IF to be compliant with USB 2.0 Standard for Android Auto<sup>TM</sup>.

### Accessory Power Socket

The accessory power sockets can be used when the power mode is in ACCESSORY or ON.

**Center pocket** 

Open the center pocket and the cover to use it.

**Console compartment** 

Open the console lid and the cover to use it.




### NOTICE

Do not insert an automotive type cigarette lighter element. This can overheat the power socket.

### Audio Remote Controls

You can operate certain functions of the audio system using the steering wheel controls.

Models with Display Audio



Volume Buttons (+/-): Press to adjust the volume.

Left Selector Wheel: Roll up/down to cycle through the available audio modes.

### Adjusting the Sound

- 1. Press the Home button.
- 2. Select an audio source icon.
- 3. Select Sound.
- 4. Select the setting you want.
- 5. Select Save.

## **Display Audio System**

Use simple gestures-including touching, swiping and scrolling-to operate certain audio functions.
