


## ■ USB Port

Install the iPod® USB connector or the USB flash drive to the USB port.

### Models with Color Audio

#### In the Center Pocket

The USB port (1.0A) is for playing audio files on a USB flash drive, connecting a cellular phone and charging devices.




### Models with Display Audio

The USB port (2.5A) is for charging devices, playing audio files and connecting compatible phones with Apple CarPlay® or Android Auto™.

### In the console compartment

The USB port (2.5A) is for charging devices, playing audio files and connecting compatible phones with Apple CarPlay<sup>®</sup> or Android Auto<sup>™</sup>.



### Rear of the center console<sup>\*1</sup>

The USB ports (2.5A) are only for charging devices.
