

CHARGING YOUR VEHICLE

Charge your vehicle's battery using either a 240V (32 amp) charge at an EV station or a 120V (12 amp) charge using a household outlet.

Time to full charge	SOC Meter "E"	Low Battery Indicator On
240 / 32A	3.3 hours	2.9 hours [1]
120 / 12A	17 hours	15 hours [1]

[1]: Charging time varies depending on conditions, such as the remaining battery level and the ambient temperature.

The suggested full charging time in this table indicates the hours it may likely take for the High Voltage battery to be fully charged from the moment the low charge indicator comes on with the ambient temperature at 77 °F.

120V Charging

1. Make sure the key is in LOCK (0) and the vehicle is in Park (P).



2. Press and hold the charge lid release button next to the steering wheel or on the key.



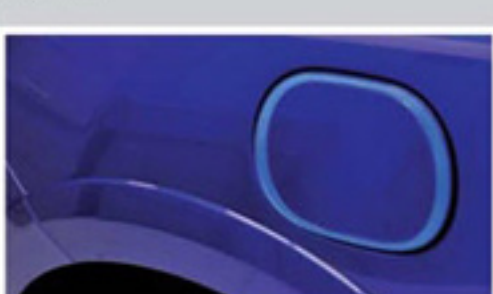
3. Open the cargo area floor lid. Remove the charge connector.



4. Insert the charge connector plug into a 120V wall socket (do not use an extension cord). The control box READY indicator comes on.



5. Open the charge lid and the inlet cover.



6. Remove the charge connector cap. Insert the charge connector into the inlet until you hear a click. The inner lid charge light and control box CHARGE indicator come on.



7. When charging is complete, press the release button on the charge connector to remove it.



8. Close the inlet cover and charge lid. Safely stow the charge connector back into the cargo area.

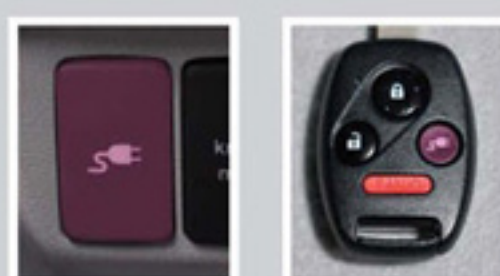


240V Charging

1. Make sure the key is in LOCK (0) and the vehicle is in Park (P).



2. Press and hold the charge lid release button next to the steering wheel or on the key.



3. Open the charge lid and the inlet cover.



4. Insert the charge connector into the inlet until you hear a click. The inner lid charge light comes on.



5. When charging is complete, press the release button on the charge connector to remove it.



6. Close the inlet cover and charge lid.



Vehicle Charging Notes:
