

AUDIO AND CONNECTIVITY

Learn how to operate the vehicle's audio system.

Basic Audio Operation

Connect audio devices and operate the audio system.

■ USB Port

Connect a USB flash drive or other audio device, such as an iPod or iPhone®. Install the flash drive or cable connector to the USB port.

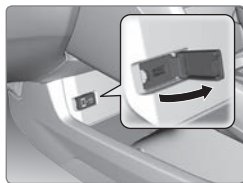
Models with color audio system

The USB port (1.0A) is located in the front console and is for playing audio and charging devices.

Models with Display Audio

The USB port (1.5A) is located in the front console and is for playing audio, charging devices, and connecting to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto.

An additional port* (1.0A) is located inside the center console. It can be used for playing audio and charging devices. You can use the sliding console tray to hold a phone or other small items.

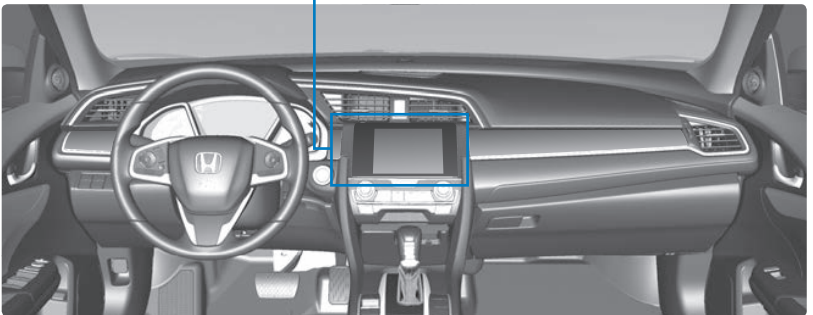
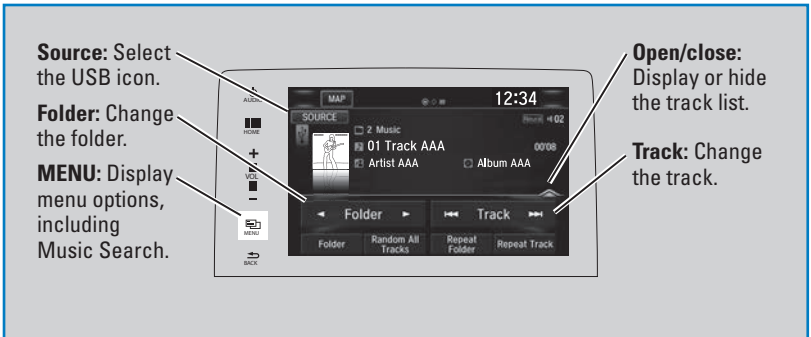


Models with Display Audio

USB Flash Drive

Play and operate a USB flash drive through the vehicle's audio system. Connect your device to the USB port.

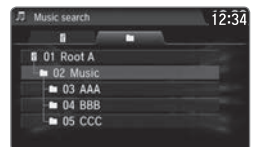
If an iPhone is connected via Apple CarPlay, the USB source is unavailable and audio files on the phone can be played only within Apple CarPlay.



■ Searching for Music

Use the touchscreen to search for tracks stored on the USB flash drive.

1. From the audio screen, press MENU.
2. Select Music Search.
3. Select Music
4. Select a folder.
5. Select the track you want to play.



On vehicles with navigation, you can also search for and play iPod music using Song By Voice.
