


■ USB Port

1. Open either USB cover in the front console.
2. Connect a USB flash drive or iPod/iPhone cable connector to the USB port.

The USB port (1.5A) is for charging devices, playing audio files and connecting for Apple CarPlay or Android Auto to the 1.5A port.


The USB port (1.0A) is for playing audio files, connecting a phone and charging devices.

USB Flash Drive

Play and operate a USB flash drive through the vehicle's audio system. Connect your device to the USB port.



■ Searching for Music

Use the touchscreen to search for tracks stored on the USB flash drive.

1. From the audio screen, press MENU.
2. Select Music Search, then Music.
3. Select a folder.
4. Select the track you want to play.



On vehicles with navigation, you can also search for and play music from the flash drive using Song By Voice.

The audio system reads and plays sounds in MP3, WMA, or iTunes-encoded AAC formats.
